## **Connerton Names Manager for New Recreational Amenity Center** *Club Connerton to open this summer*

**TAMPA, Fla.** (May 13, 2008) – Connerton has announced Jon Liles will manage Club Connerton, the community’s social and recreational activities center. Liles will be responsible for the daily operations, staff and activities provided at Club Connerton, opening this summer.

Club Connerton’s first phase opening in July is planned to total more than 10,000 square feet and include a variety of different amenities. Liles is currently Connerton’s activities director and works for WTS International, the professional leisure management company employed by Connerton’s Community Association. Liles has organized events such as outdoor walking clubs, picnics and junior group play days.

### **About Connerton**

Connerton is a 4,800-acre mixed-use master planned community in central Pasco County and the only designated “New Town” currently under construction on the west coast of Florida. In total, approximately 8,500 residential units are planned with more than 3 million square feet of commercial space for office, retail and industrial uses. The Arbors, the first village in Connerton, is nearly sold out. Village Two, The Gardens, is now selling.

The community currently features amenities including a Village Center with a Publix Super Market, banks and other convenient shops and services; and walking trails, boardwalks, neighborhood parks and conservation areas. Fitness and aquatics complex, an amphitheatre and a long-term acute-care medical facility are under construction; a hospital, medical offices, a regional park and three schools and a town center are also planned.
